

STATEMENT OF FAITH

- That the Bible is the inspired Word of God
- In the eternal Godhead, Who has revealed Himself as One God, existing in three persons, even the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit; individually distinguishable but indivisible in essence; coeternal, co-equal and co-existent in attributes, power, nature and glory.
- In the virgin birth, sinless life, miraculous ministry, atoning death, bodily resurrection, triumphal ascension and abiding intercession of the Lord Jesus Christ, and in His second advent as the blessed hope set before all believers.
- In the fall of man, who was created in the image of God, but fell by voluntary transgression.
- In salvation through repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and His substitutionary death upon the cross.
 - In Baptism by total immersion in water.
- We are members of the Body of Christ. We must seek to have good relationships with the broader Church.
- In the Baptism in the Holy Spirit being the incoming of the promised Comforter to empower the believer with power from on high for effective witness and service.
- That the nine gifts of the Holy Spirit, as set out in **I Corinthians 12**, are bestowed upon the believing church and are operated by believers as and when they are anointed to do so by the Holy Spirit. In the holiness of life and conduct, in line with Godly principles set out in the volume of Scripture.
- That the Communion as instituted by the Lord Jesus Christ at the Last Supper is enjoined upon all believers until the Lord returns again.

- That deliverance from sickness by Divine Healing is provided for in the Atonement.
- In everlasting life for all who truly believe in our Lord Jesus Christ and that hell is the portion of all whose names are not recorded in the Book of Life.
- In the five fold offices of Apostle, Prophet, Pastor, Evangelist, Teacher in Ephesians 4:11-12. They function to build up the Body for the work of the ministry, as divinely selected and appointed by the Holy Spirit.
- The priesthood of all believers. (1 Peter 2:9)
- Discipleship is fundamental to our being the Church. A life long apprenticeship to the ways, truth and life of Jesus Christ.
- For a mighty and sovereign move of God.
- In the principle of tithes and offerings as an act of worship. Giving should be regular and proportionate to our income.
